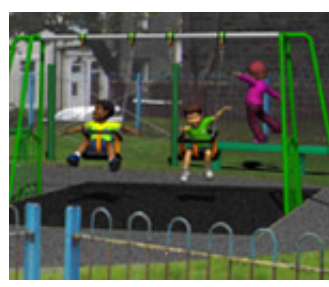
STEPS (Support, Training, Encouragement of Practical Skills)

BBC Radio 4 Gardeners Question Time at Carlisle Business Centre (CBC)

BCEP (Bradford Community Environment Project) and allotment holders on Scotchman Rd were amongst the local partners who took part in the BBC Radio 4 programme Gardener's Question Time.

It was hosted by BCEP and was broadcast on the 7th Jan and repeated on 9th Jan.

A capacity crowd of 180 gardeners filled the main hall to hear the panel of experts. Earlier in the day, two of the panel had visited some of the women involved in BCEP's Grow Organic programme who come together every week and grow food on allotments in Scotchman Rd.

Manningham Masterplan has been working with BCEP and Scotchman Rd Allotments Association to improve the site and helped with sourcing £3750 worth of free water butts for allotment holders from Yorkshire Water.
